The Vicar of Dibley at Audlem Methodist Church

Our production of 'The Vicar of Dibley' was enjoyed by over 350 people in March. The audiences on the four evenings all left smiling and full of praise for the performances of the young cast, and for the varied musical contributions from the adult choir. It was great to be able to provide some cheer and fun during the last month of our dreary winter. Many thanks to all those who gave their time and talents so generously over the months of preparation.



We were happy to be involved again with Audlem Primary School in March, when the Year 5 class came to us for a series of workshops on Easter, using drama and activity as well as story-telling. Responses from the children have been very encouraging, so further events are to be planned.

ADAPT Food Group

We meet monthly at a member's house and in February we swapped surplus seed and tips for germination. Visits to allotments and gardens are planned and we will have stalls at local events such as the Hankelow fete, and the RNLI event at Overwater. We will also support the Woore show and have offered assistance. The Saturday market stall in the centre of Audlem will start when the weather is warmer, beginning with seedlings. Anyone with surplus home-produced items is welcome to join or to donate the proceeds to buy more equipment. Keep an eye on AudlemOnline for market stall news and our seasonal recipes. We hope to produce a booklet of recipes – they are also archived on the AudlemOnline ADAPT pages.



Audlem Music and Arts Festival – 24th to 28th May

The Audlem Festival team is a very small group of volunteers whose aim is to present a successful event each year, for which their only reward is the satisfaction of a job well done.

The main aim is to raise enough funds to put on this event free of charge. There are five days and nights of musical performances with some 90 solos, duos and groups playing and singing for you in the pubs, Public Hall Annexe, St James' Church and Methodist Church.

Along with fine music to suit all tastes, is a superb Art Exhibition of mostly local talents which each year receives much praise and a Poetry Slam and workshops.

To date we have raised around 75% of the funds needed - either by payment or by promises. The total cost is in excess of £16,000 and it takes a lot of dedicated work to obtain this large amount.

We have full commitment from the three pubs so far and our glossy programme is nearly complete with over a hundred adverts, notices and details of the musical and arts events. (All print and extra art work being done by Joe Sheldon of Audlem Printers.) We have permission again from Eric Callwood for the use of his field for camping during the weekend.

From Crewe via Elba to Canada

The History Society have travelled far and wide in their recent talks. Talks on railways always prove popular and February was no exception with David Cooke telling us of the Railway Colony in Crewe. This was followed, in March, by the story of the Sicilian Zenon Vantini who became the House Steward at Trentham and then went on to open the first railway hotel at Euston station.

Our April talk was given by Ian Jones, one of our members, an excellent stand-in for our previously advertised speaker.
