

ANNUAL REPORT

Our village fete last year took place on June 17th and was a great Success. We were able to give £500 each to our chosen charities, Audlem 1st Responders and the North West Air Ambulance. We gave £150 to Hankelow Methodist Church, £50 to the Fire Fighters Charity, £30 to Greenbank for electricity and £60 to the Broad Lane School Choir.
